OUR COMMITMENT TO YOUR SAFETY

The Safest Place To Meet is the protection concept of **maintenance and PUMPS & VALVES Dortmund**. With this concept our trade shows are controlled and safe for visitors, exhibitors and employees.

Trade shows are irreplaceable for personal contact, building trust between suppliers and users, the initiation of business relationships and the experience of new products and solutions. Even under the framework conditions necessitated by the Covid-19 pandemic, all participants should feel comfortable at maintenance and PUMPS & VALVES Dortmund and achieve their trade show objectives.

Your safety is our top priority. The protection concept is based on the hygiene and infection standards of the CoronaSchVO of the respective federal state in which the trade show takes place. In addition, the Easyfairs Group behind maintenance and PUMPS & VALVES Dortmund Messe has raised its already high hygiene standards and developed new health and safety standards.

We look forward to welcoming you again at maintenance and PUMPS & VALVES Dortmund. The trade show team, the exhibition centre and the entire Easyfairs Group will do their utmost to make the trade show duo a safe and important place for your B2B contacts.

If necessary, the concept will be adapted to changing requirements of the authorities and to the current framework conditions until the trade show date.

SAFETY & HYGIENE MEASURES

1. REGISTRATION, ENTRANCE AND PAYMENT

All trade show participants (exhibitors, visitors, media representatives, stand constructors, catering staff, etc.) are **registered** with the **essential personal data**. Wherever possible, this is done online and ahead of the show.

Visitors can activate their **free tickets** on the trade show website as before.

Ticket and access control is contactless and electronic. Visitors are also scanned when leaving the venue. In this way, it is always possible to document who and how many people are at the venue.

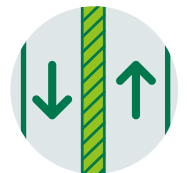


Markings on the floor ensure that the **minimum distances of 1.5 meters are observed** in the registration area.

A **guidance system** will guide visitors at relevant points in and through the exhibition hall.



Entrance and exit areas are - wherever possible - spatially separated from each other.



Contactless payment is offered and recommended.



SAFETY & HYGIENE MEASURES

2. DURING THE EXHIBITION AND IN THE EXHIBITION HALL

The **access control system** makes it possible to **check** at any time how many people are in the exhibition hall and ensures that the permitted number of people is not exceeded.



By allocating **time slots** for visitors to the show, **at least the same number of people as in the previous year** can visit the show and it is avoided that visitors cannot be admitted immediately upon arrival.



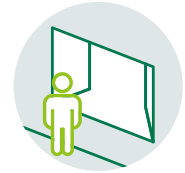
Generous additional space with networking tables enables exhibitors to hold **one-to-one talks** with visitors outside the stand. The Networking Tables are equipped with plexiglass shields and are placed at a sufficient distance from each other.



In the **lecture area**, the seating is adjusted to ensure that the **minimum distances of 1.5 meters** are observed.



Where possible, **outdoor areas** will be made accessible to trade show visitors and exhibitors.

3. HYGIENE AND PROTECTION MEASURES

Except at seats and in the catering area, there is an obligation to wear a **face mask** for the protection of all trade show participants.



Hand sanitiser stations are set up everywhere.



Exhibitors will also be provided with **hand sanitisers** and **surface disinfectants free of charge** for the stand.



Face masks and **disposable gloves** will be provided **free of charge** if required.

3. HYGIENE AND PROTECTION MEASURES

People with **cold symptoms** are asked to stay at home and are not allowed to enter the venue.



Shields of glass or plexiglass are installed at **all registration and information counters**.



All ventilation systems are operated with the **maximum possible proportion of outside air**. Hall doors and access doors are kept open as far as possible.



A **comprehensive and intensive cleaning concept** applies to all areas of the show, which is implemented at increased intervals, especially for critical areas.



4. CATERING

The **catering concepts will comply with the hygiene and industry standards applicable** at the time of the show (e.g. only to-go and packaged goods).

The areas set aside for catering will be expanded compared to previous shows.



5. COMMUNICATION AND INFORMATION

All trade show participants will be informed beforehand to SOLIDS & RECYCLING-TECHNIK Dortmund about **hygiene and protective measures**.

Information material and signs on the hygiene and protective measures will be equally distributed at the show.



Compliance with the protection and hygiene measures will be supported on site by additional staff.
